ORDINATION AND INSTALLATION MASS - BISHOP-ELECT ROBERT MARSHAL

The Ordination and Installation Mass of Bishop-Elect Robert W. Marshall, will take place at St. Francis Xavier Cathedral on Thursday, August 20,

2020 at 2:00 PM. Because of the continued safety and social distancing guidelines of the diocese and state health agencies, all seats in the Cathedral have been assigned to members of the clergy, family, religious, a select number of civil officials, and members of the family of Bishop Marshall only.

Important to the event will be two (2) lay representatives from each parish and mission in the diocese. Those chosen will receive a ticket for admittance at the Divine Providence Center of Our Lady of Prompt Succor Church, located at the corner of Elliott and 21st Streets, Alexandria. Due to restrictions because of COVID-19, parish representatives will not be able to attend in person at the Cathedral. A live-stream broadcast of the Mass will be presented directly from the Cathedral. The Holy Eucharist from the Ordination Mass will be distributed at the Divine Providence Center during Communion time.

SOLEMN VESPERS

Due to very limited seating, only clergy, religious and members of the family of Bishop Marshall will be invited at Solemn Vespers at 6:00 PM on Wednesday, August 19.

PLEASE NOTE: The Ordination and Installation Mass at 2:00 PM on August 20th and Solemn Vespers at 6:00 PM on August 19th will be live-streamed on the Cathedral's facebook page, youtube channel, and the Diocese of Alexandria website.

THE RITE OF CHRISTIAN INITIATION FOR ADULTS - SEPTEMBER 20, 2020

The Rite of Christian Initiation for Adults (RCIA) is a formal process of catechetical instruction whereby adults

are formally admitted into the Catholic Church and receive the Sacraments of Initiation – Baptism, Confirmation, and Holy Eucharist. Classes for adults who are interested in becoming Catholic will begin on **Sunday, September 20, 2020 in the church hall at 10:00 AM.**

The classes are also for adult Catholics who are baptized in the Catholic Church but did not receive their First Holy Communion and/or Confirmation.

MASS SCHEDULES FOR THE CATHEDRAL

The weekday Mass schedules are Monday thru Friday at 12:05 p.m. The weekend Mass schedules are Saturday Anticipated Mass at 4:00 p.m., Sunday Masses at 9:00 a.m., 11:00 a.m. and 5:30 p.m. With the state in Phase Two, this means that the number of persons gathered in Church can be 50% of the total occupancy which is about 140 people per Mass. Wearing a face covering is strongly advised. Also we must continue to observe social distancing which requires persons to be six feet apart. The only exception to this is people living in the same household.
