BIBLE STUDY – THE EUCHARIST IN SCRIPTURE BEGINNING, TUESDAY, JUNE 13, 6:00 P.M. IN XAVIER HALL

In The Eucharist in Scripture, discover God's plan as it is expressed through the Bible and the Mass. This six-lesson study, presented by Dr. Scott Hahn, will unlock the meaning of covenant, sacrifice, and sacrament as understood in the Bible, from Genesis through Revelation. "The Eucharist in Scripture examines the biblical foundations of the Eucharist and explores the Church's liturgy as the original context for the books of the Bible.

This six-week bible study will begin on **Tuesday, June 13 at 6:00 PM in Xavier Hall and every Tuesday (except July 4) until July 25.** Each video session is about 30 minutes. After the video, we would have 15 minutes of open discussion as we eat at our respective tables. The evening will last approximately 1 hour and 15 minutes.
