DIOCESE MOURNS DEATH OF BELOVED PRIEST

Fr. Daniel Corkery, a priest of the Diocese of Alexandria, passed from this life on Holy Thursday, March 28, 2024, in Hessmer, Louisiana, at the age of 94. Fr. Corkery was born in Ireland. Attracted to missionary life abroad, he responded to Bishop Charles P. Greco's appeal and was ordained a priest for the Diocese of Alexandria on June 5th, 1955. Fr. Corkery retired from active ministry in August, 2009, after 54 years of dedicated service. A Funeral Mass was held for Fr. Corkery at St. Francis Xavier Cathedral on Thursday, April 4. He was laid to rest at the Maryhill Priests Cemetery in Pineville. May he rest in peace.
